

While you're waiting

One of the highlights of life is going to the golf club to meet with friends and play golf. But nothing is so good that it cannot be improved and – honestly – how much time do you stand around waiting? Waiting for a start time, waiting for the prizegiving after a competition, waiting for the children to finish their round. Waiting isn't always fun. But this can be changed with a mini-golf course.

Fun for everyone

One of the major reasons for investing in a mini-golf course is that the club's own members benefit. Members will enjoy visiting the club even if they don't have the time to play 9 or 18 holes. A mini-golf course is also an attraction for those players who do not have a green card, or for children who are not yet allowed out on the course.

Increased revenue

A mini-golf course of 9 or 18 holes is also a potential source of income. Our experience is that a mini-golf course often pays for itself within two years.

And if members spend more time at the club, this will increase sales in the restaurant, pro shop, etc.

Improve putting on a perfect surface

In every round of golf, the putter is used more than any other club, but how often do you practice putting? Putting is undoubtedly the most important stroke in golf, and yet many of us spend little time on the putting green.

The putting surface is perfect on a mini-golf course, and you play with your own putter. No spike marks or other hazards to affect the roll of the ball – a correctly struck ball will go in the hole. A player can improve putting skills in pleasant conditions on the mini-golf course, and with a real element of excitement.

We have more plans to develop products to facilitate putting practice.

A useful complement

A mini-golf course allows the club to increase its range of services. One example is that companies, sponsors, and customers can be invited to informal gatherings, and the good lunch can be rounded off with a round of mini-golf. This provides an interesting alternative, even for people who do not play golf.

As with golf, the advantage of mini-golf is that virtually everyone can play, both young and old. A mini-golf course can be used as an additional facility in different arrangements at the golf club. Maybe play-offs could be held on the mini-golf course? Exciting competitions can be arranged that don't take so long.


